

SCHEDULING ORDER

OFFICER MCHUGH, et al.,

Defendants' motion for an order dismissing the complaint for lack of subject matter jurisdiction and for failure to state a claim came on for hearing before this court on November 10, 2004. Plaintiffs Robert-John:Foti and Ken Augustine appeared in proper, plaintiff Joe Neufeld did not appear, and defendants United States Marshals Service. Federal Protective Services, and Officer McHugh appeared by their counsel, Assistant United States Attorney Tracie L. Brown.

On November 9, 2004, the day preceding the day set for the hearing on defendants' motion, plaintiffs filed a first amended complaint, adding allegations and at least one new cause of action. At the hearing, the court advised plaintiffs that the defendants would be given an opportunity to file a response to the amended complaint, and set a briefing schedule.

Also at the hearing, plaintiff Robert-John: Foti inquired why plaintiffs had not been given an immediate hearing on their request for injunctive relief. The court explained to Mr. Foti that because plaintiffs had filed no written motion for injunctive relief, with a statement of legal authority supporting such a request, but had simply written "Immediate Emergency Hearing requesting Injunctive Relief requested" on the caption page of their complaint, the

court did not consider that a motion had been made. The court asked Mr. Foti whether he wished to file a written motion for injunctive relief, and he stated that he did not. The court then advised him that defendants would be given an opportunity to file an opposition to the request for injunctive relief set forth in the first amended complaint, and set a briefing schedule.

The briefing schedule set by the court is as follows: Defendants may file an opposition to the request for injunctive relief. Any such opposition shall be filed and served no later than Wednesday, November 24, 2004. Plaintiffs may file a reply to the opposition. Any such reply shall be filed and served no later than Wednesday, December 1, 2004.

Defendants may file a motion to dismiss the first amended complaint. Any such motion shall be filed and served no later than Wednesday, November 24, 2004. Plaintiffs may file an opposition to the motion. Any such opposition shall be filed and served no later than Wednesday, December 8, 2004. Any reply to the opposition shall be filed and served no later than Wednesday, December 15, 2004.

The court will issue a written decision on the papers. There will be no oral argument. The case management conference is VACATED, and will be rescheduled after the court has issued its rulings on the pending motions.
