On Sunday, 01/02/2005, at approximately 0808 hours, suspect Ibrahim was checking in at United Airlines counter 15, terminal #3, for a flight to Kona, HI. United Airlines supervisor David Nevins notified dispatch that Ibrahims was on the federal government no fly list. Dispatch sent me to the scene.

I arrived at the scene and I did a criminal check on Ibrahim. Sgt. Pate checked the no fly list and Ibrahim was on the list. Sgt. Pate called the TSIS in Washington D.C. and spoke to Agent John Bondanella. Agent Bondanella told Sgt. Pate to deny the flight to Ibrahim, contact the F.B.I. and to detain her for further questioning. Sgt. Pate notified Lt. Cottura. Lt. Cottura notified Captain Williams and the TSA at the airport. I advised Ibrahim that she was going to be detained at the police station at terminal #1. Ibrahim told me that the F.B.I had questioncd her a week ago. I handcuffed Ibraheim and placed her in the rear of my patrol vehicle. Officer Ongpin and I transported her to the police substation in terminal #1.

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We arrived at the substation and Officer Elizabeth Maron searched suspect Ibrahim. Ibrahim was placed on the bench in the holding cell area. She stated that she had blood pressure problems. I called dispatch and they sent the fire department paramedics and AMR Ambulance Service to do a medical check. They did a medical check and she was clear. TSA Inspector Lee Korman arrived at the scene. F.B.I Agent Paul Wood was notified. F.B.I. Agent Kevin Kelley (408-535-4654) was assigned to this case , but was unavailable.

At approximately, 1115 hours, F.B.I. Agent Woods, via the phone, contacted Lt. Cottura. Woods requested that Ibrahim be released for further investigation by their office. Woods said that Ibrahim`s status was going to be changed on the list to a selectee rather than a no fly status. Lt. Cottura and Inspector Korman advised Ibrahim that she was being released. I gave Ibrahim a signed 849(b)(1) pc form which is attached to this report along with a copy of the CLEP information. Inspector Korman and Officer Ongpin assisted Ibrahim back to United Airlines so that she could be rebooked to a direct flight on United Airlines to Kona on Monday, 01/03/05.

PENAL CODE SECTION 849 PROVIDES, IN PART:

(a) When an arrest is made without a warrant by a peace officer or private person, the person arrested, if not otherwise released, shall, without unnecessary delay, be taken before the nearest or most accessible magistrate in the county in which the offense is triable, and a complaint stating the charge against the arrested person be laid before such magistrate.

(b) Any peace officer may release from custody, instead of taking such person before a magistrate, any person arrested without a warrant whenever:

(1) He is satisfied that there are insufficient grounds for making a criminal complaint against the person arrested.

(2) The person was arrested for intoxication only, and no further proceedings are desirable.

(3) The person was arrested only for being under the influence of a narcotic, drug, or restricted dangerous drug and such person is delivered to a facility or hospital for treatment and no further proceedings are desirable.

(c) Any record of arrest of a person released pursuant to paragraphs (1) and (3) of subdivision (b) shall include a record of release. Thereafter, such arrest shall not be deemed an arrest, but a detention.

PENAL CODE SECTION 849.5 PROVIDES:

In any case in which a person is arrested and released and no accusatory pleading is filed charging him with an offense, any record of arrest of the person shall include a record of release. Thereafter, the arrest shall not be deemed an arrest, but a detention only.

PENAL CODE SECTION 851.6 PROVIDES, IN PART:

(a) In any case in which a person is arrested and released pursuant to paragraph (1) or (3) of subdivision (b) of Section 849, the person shall be issued a certificate, signed by the releasing officer or his superior officer, describing the action as a detention.

(b) In any case in which a person is arrested and released and no accusatory pleading is filed charging him with an offense, the person shall be issued a certificate by the law enforcement agency which arrested him describing the action as a detention.

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
