This is in response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request dated August 29, 2012. You requested records pertaining to the designation by the Secretary of Transportation of a single contact officer responsible for overall coordination of the implementation of Executive Order 13107 (Implementation of Human Rights Treaties) by the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT), and any related communications, policies, procedures, directives, instructions, public notices, logs, dockets, list, or reports.

A search within DOT failed to disclose records responsive to your request.

I am the person responsible for this determination. If you are dissatisfied with this response, you may appeal to Judith S. Kaleta, Deputy General Counsel, U.S. Department of Transportation, Washington, D.C. 20590. An appeal must be made in writing and be submitted within 30 days after you receive this determination. It should contain any information and arguments you wish to rely on, and the envelope in which the appeal is sent should be prominently marked "FOIA Appeal." The Deputy General Counsel's determination will be administratively final.
