This is the electronic final response to your January 21, 2016, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) for records pertaining to the following: 1. access records pertaining to individuals presenting driver's licenses that are or were not considered compliant, or from states or territories that are or were not considered compliant, with the REAL-ID Act of 2005, for purpose of accessing Federal facilities and/or passing through checkpoints at airports or elsewhere, including any records of the numbers of such individuals, statistical or descriptive records pertaining to such incidents, email messages pertaining to such incidents or reports, and any instructions regarding handling and/or reporting of such incidents, and; 2. records pertaining to the legal basis for denial or potential denial of access to Federal facilities, denial of passage through checkpoints at airports, or denial of transport by airlines or surface transportation carriers, on the basis of the REAL-ID Act of 2005, including any reports analyzing these issues and any email messages pertaining to them. This office received your request on January 21, 2016.

In responding to a FOIA request, DHS/Privacy Office will search for responsive documents in its control on the date the search began. We began our search on February 1, 2016. A search of the DHS/Office of Policy, **Office of State Issued Identification Support** for documents responsive to your request produced a total of 13 pages.

We are granting your request under FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552, and DHS' implementing regulations, 6 C.F.R. Part 5. After carefully reviewing the responsive documents, I determined that they are appropriate for public release. The documents are enclosed in their entirety; DHS has claimed no deletions or exemptions.

Additionally, upon review of your request, I have determined that the information you are seeking also falls under the purview of the Transportation Security Administration (TSA). Therefore, your request was referred to the FOIA Officer for TSA, Regina McCoy, for processing and direct response to you. You may contact that office in writing at Transportation

Provisions of FOIA allow us to recover part of the cost of complying with your request. In this instance, because the cost is below the \$14 minimum, there is no charge.
