Short Description	Your Priority
<p>S2S Compliance</p> <p>Determine what it means for participating States to be S2S compliant. Using the existing DIVS compliance documentation as a reference; identify metrics to measure jurisdictions’ compliance, frequency of measuring, and how support can be provided to jurisdictions’ to reach and/or maintain compliance.</p>	1
<p>Citizen Request</p> <p>A basic privacy principle is that a person should be able to find out if the S2S verification service contains information that pertains to themselves. A corollary to this principle is that the person should be able to have information corrected if it is found to be in error. If a citizen asks if S2S contains information that pertains to them, how should such a request be handled?</p> <p>DIVS proposed a process that would have AAMVA playing an important part. AAMVA would carry responsibility and potentially liability.</p> <p>AAMVA to study the DIVS proposal and report to the Governance Committee on viability, and if needed, on alternatives.</p>	2
