On behalf of Governor Edmund G. Brown Jr., this letter serves as California's request for a REAL ID Act full compliance determination.

As indicated in the Department of Homeland Security's October 16, 2017, letter, California was granted an extension until October 10, 2018, to come into compliance with the REAL ID Act. Effective January 22, 2018, the California Department of Motor Vehicles (CADMV) began offering optional REAL ID compliant driver licenses and identification (DL/ID) cards. Please find the attached "California's Progress Towards Complying with the REAL ID Act" (Attachment A) document, the "Compliance Package" (Attachment B) document, and the Certification Letter.
