RE: Data Practices Request

Dear Mr. Hasbrouck,

The Metropolitan Airports Commission ("MAC") is in receipt of your January 20, 2026 request for information under the Minnesota Government Data Practices Act ("MGDPA").

After review of your request, the MAC has the following responses to the requests for information. The MAC's responses are indicated in *italics* below the request.

In your request, you asked for:

- (1) All data that identify or include a citation to the specific federal regulation(s) referenced in the [MAC's January 15, 2026 statement].

The MAC does not have governmental data responsive to this request. Data relevant to the MAC's legal analysis of the federal regulatory schema that was referenced in the MAC's January 15, 2026 statement would have been used, collected, stored, or disseminated by attorneys retained by the MAC to advise on the statement. Such data, if extant, are exempted from public disclosure under Minnesota Statutes, section 13.393.

- (2) All data that document any opinion, assessment, or report prepared by or at the direction or request of the MAC concerning (a) the authority of the MAC to limit or control the scope of access by employees and/or contractors of ICE and/or other federal agencies to MAC property or portions thereof, including but not limited to jetbridges, (b) the authority of ICE or other federal agents to detain or search passengers or conduct "document checks" on jetbridges or to interfere with their ability to access flights, (c) the authority of the MAC to post notices to passengers concerning their rights, (d) the basis for, or legal validity of, the statement quoted above posted on the MAC website.

The MAC does not have governmental data responsive to this request. Any such opinions, assessments, communications, and reports would have been used, collected, stored, or disseminated by attorneys retained by the MAC to advise on these issues. Such data, if extant, are exempted from public disclosure under Minnesota Statutes, section 13.393.

- (3) All data that document any discussion of the legal basis for the portion of the statement quoted above posted on the MAC website [sic].

The MAC does not have governmental data responsive to this request. Any such communications would have been used, collected, stored, or disseminated by attorneys retained by the MAC to advise on these

legal bases. Such data, if extant, are exempted from public disclosure under Minnesota Statutes, section 13.393.

- (4) All data that document any communication from ICE or any federal agency to the MAC regarding the claimed authority of ICE or other federal agencies to station agents or conduct "document checks" on jetbridges.

The MAC has no data responsive to this request.

- (5) All data that document any communications by or on behalf of the MAC to employees and/or contractors concerning possible presence of ICE agents or contractors or "document checks" on jetbridges.

The MAC has no data responsive to this request.

- (6) All data that document any communications by or on behalf of the MAC to ICE or other federal agencies concerning presence or possible presence of ICE agents or "document checks" on jetbridges at MSP.

The MAC has no data responsive to this request.
